INTERNSHIP CREDIT

Students who find an internship can get academic credit for it by enrolling in their major's Internship / Practicum / Capstone Project class for 4 credits.

To receive the credits, the student must submit an evaluation from their internship supervisor that is at least satisfactory, i.e. the equivalent of a passing grade.

The internship must be in the area of the student's program and develop skills and/or knowledge relevant to the student's field of study or similarly positioned to skills or knowledge typically gained from another NewU class.

In addition, the internship must be at least two months long to qualify for academic credit.
