Based on that central tenet, the university leverages the vast resources of the Library of Congress and DC Public Library for the benefit of its students, faculty, and staff.

NewU will secure, maintain, and support our community in gaining and sustaining continuous access to all physical and electronic resources offered by these two great libraries to their members.

The university will not collect, store, and manage any on-campus physical library collections when the biggest DC public library (MLK branch) and the largest library in the world (The Library of Congress), are located within a few city blocks of NewU's campus, and readily available to our students, faculty, and staff.

This model ensures unsurpassed access to physical and digital library resources at zero cost to students, parents, and the NewU community in alignment with NewU's mission and vision.
